INSTRUCTIONS

1. All students must enrol in Holy Trinity Catholic Secondary School's Religious Education program. This entails completion of one Religion credit for each of the four years of secondary school.
2. When choosing a course, students must ensure that they have successfully completed the appropriate prerequisite course.
3. Students in senior grades must take care that choices are appropriate both to the fulfilment of secondary school diploma requirements and to the prerequisites necessary for post-secondary programs.
4. Parent's signature indicates awareness of and agreement with the selections made.
5. The school's timetable is built based upon the choices indicated by students and their parents on this Course Selection Sheet. Requests for changes after the timetable has been set will only be made at the discretion of school officials.
6. Choices should be listed in order of priority and alternative choices must be provided so that conflicts, which could arise, may be resolved. If insufficient choices are provided, school officials will make appropriate choices.
7. The school reserves the right to cancel course offerings if they are under subscribed.
8. Study periods are a privilege and may only be granted at the discretion of school officials to students who have successfully completed 24 credits.
9. There is a compulsory student fee of \$50.00, which should be submitted with the Course Selection Sheet. Cheques may be made payable to **Holy Trinity Catholic Secondary School** and the name of the student should be printed on the cheque.
