Holy Trinity Catholic School has arranged for your child to participate in a ski and snowboard program at Brimacombe, formerly known as the Oshawa Ski Club, on January 10th, 2012, January 17th, 2012, February 7th, 2012, February 14th, 2012, February 21st, 2012 and February 28th, 2012.

To assist with trip planning, the school has chosen to participate in Brimacombe's online registration program. We are asking all parents to register their children for this trip using this system. Please note, no online payments will be required.

Once you have completed the registration process, you will be asked to print and sign all required forms and return them to Holy Trinity Catholic School with full payment by December 16th, 2011.

How to Register for this Trip:

1. Go to www.brimacombe.ca/trips to begin the registration process. Follow the on-screen prompts.

Things to Know Before You Register

Ability Level

Never	has never been before
Beginner	has been once or twice; can stop and turn; is controlled on beginner runs
Intermediate	has been on many occasions on a variety of hills; can stop and turn with control on most terrain
Advanced	is experienced and competent; has had formal instruction; demonstrates ability at an advanced level. Can be called upon to assist supervisors, if necessary.

Lift Tickets \$84.00

Members of Brimacombe are not required to pay for a lift ticket. All other students will require lift tickets.

Lessons \$66.00

Skiers and snowboarders must always be in control and be able to stop and change direction to avoid collisions with people and objects. Please take this into consideration before choosing not to take lessons.

Rentals

All students must wear an appropriate snow sport helmet and all equipment must be in safe, working condition.

The following rental equipment is available:

Ski Package (Includes skis, ski boots, poles) \$72.00

Snowboard Package (Includes snowboard, snowboard boots) \$72.00

Helmet (Please Note: All participants MUST wear an appropriate snow sport helmet for school excursions to Brimacombe.) \$36.00
